Saddle up and join our weekend trail ride through Vermont's Beautiful Mountains in Tunbridge VT. At the Tunbridge Fair Grounds

The weekend includes 2 day rides with an approximately 15 to 20 mile loop each day. (A short cut route will be available after we reach the lunch spot). Dogs are welcome but must be leashed at all times, The trails are up and down hillsides, be sure to check those shoes & get your horse and self in shape for this great weekend of riding. ☺

FRIDAY, September 24th Arrival starting at 1:00PM

Arrival 1:00 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. Check in at the North end of the fairgrounds only. Across from the village store between two large brick buildings. If you arrive before **1:00** Fair grounds will charge you an extra \$20.00 to be paid at check-in-gate. Bring a garden hose and extension cord for the electricity you might not park right next to the pole.

SATURDAY, September 25 Arrival starting at 7:00 am.

7:30 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. Scrambled eggs, bacon, home fries, toast & english muffins, fresh fruit, coffee, juice
8:15 a.m. **Required Riders meeting** at Dodge Gilman building, for trail talk.
10:00 a.m. **No Sooner!** Riders begin staggered rides. Trail markers are leaving at 9:00 for last check of trails. Bagged lunch and beverages will be provided at the half way point on the trail
5:30 p.m. Roast Beef w/gravy, Spaghetti & Meatballs, seasoned roasted red potato, tossed salad, Vegetable Normandy with cream sauce, Apple Crisp & ice cream, hot and cold drinks
7:00 p.m. Large bonfire, near center of ring, If you have instruments to play please bring them.

SUNDAY, September 26

7:30 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. French Toast with real Vt. maple syrup, 2 sausage, home fries, fresh fruit, coffee, juice
8:15 a.m. Riders meeting at Dodge Gilman building for trail talk.
10:00 a.m. Riders begin staggered rides. Lunch when you return from trail ride in refrigerators in the Dodge Gilman Building. Please only take one of each item, including the cookies.
3:00 p.m. All packed up and leaving fair grounds.

Stalls are available. If you use a stall, you are responsible for cleaning it. Owner must provide bedding.

Stalls must be stripped before leaving.

Bring portable fencing if you want to keep your horse next to your campsite, approx. 16 X 16 area.

Horses must wear a halter or bridle at all times

****Every Rider is responsible for cleaning up after themselves and their horse(s).****

All grounds must be free of manure by the end of the weekend, including the track. Your help is greatly appreciated.

SHOWERS. There are 2 showers available at the top of the hill above the Dodge Gilman building on the left. Several toilets are available through out the fair grounds.

Directions to the Tunbridge Fair Grounds:

From the South: I-89 to exit 2 on to Rt. 14 north approx. 7 miles to South Royalton. Turn right onto 110. Approx. 6 miles to Fairgrounds on left.

From the North: I 89 to exit 3 left on 107 to Rt. 14 south approx. 5 miles to South Royalton. Turn left onto 110. Approx. 6 miles to Fairgrounds on left.
